

Metric Treasure Hunt

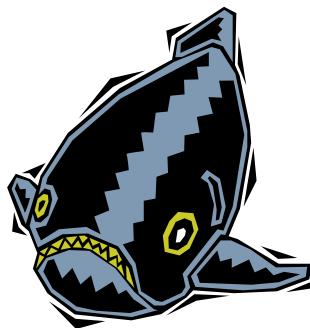
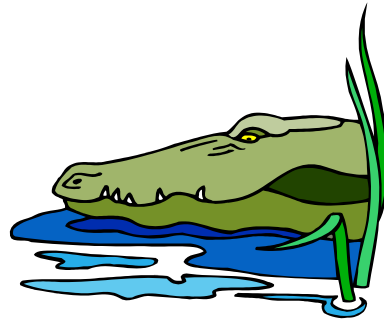

As the ship was going down, you were handed a piece of paper by one of the passengers that perished in the wreck. He begged you to keep it safe and to continue his search. Not knowing what search the dying man was on, you took the paper anyway. As you gather your thoughts, alone on this island, you open the wet and crumpled piece of paper. On it are directions to a promised treasure. With the directions are warnings! Alligators, piranha, quicksand, bottomless pits, impassable jungles and a place called "Dead Man's Gulch" are lying in your path. Because it is so dark you must follow the measurements carefully to the treasure or you may end up perishing!

Starting at the center of the "X," draw your path on the back of this paper. When you have reached the treasure, place a star at the end of your path.

I recommend using a pencil and making sure your paper is straight each time you draw a new line. All lines should be horizontal or vertical.

Starting at the middle of the X at the bottom of the page, draw a line going:

- North 5 centimeters
- East 1.7 centimeters
- South 2.6 centimeters
- East 2 centimeters
- North 4.5 centimeters
- West 2.5 centimeters
- North 13.5 centimeters
- East 7.2 centimeters
- South 12 centimeters
- West 1 centimeter
- North 6.8 centimeters
- West 1.8 centimeters
- South 12.5 centimeters
- East 5.3 centimeters
- South 2.7 centimeters
- East 4.8 centimeters
- North 14.2 centimeters
- West 4 centimeters



- Unless you have perished, you should have your treasure. Draw a small star at this point. You will compare your map to the actual map as seen in the daylight.
